

COVID-19 Policies & Procedures: Revised 4/13/21

The following guidelines must be followed to ensure the health and safety of all involved. We expect ministry leaders to enforce these policies with your teams:

- All must wear masks (unless leading worship with a microphone)
- All must practice social distancing, keeping at least 6 feet between yourself and another person not in your household
- Self screening questions for all in attendance:
 - Within the last 72 hours, have you had:
 - A fever (100.4 F or higher) or feeling feverish?
 - Chills?
 - A new or worsening cough?
 - Shortness of breath?
 - Travel on an airplane?
 - Exposure to anyone with COVID-19 symptoms or who has tested positive for COVID-19?
 - Two of the following symptoms:
 - A new sore throat?
 - New muscle aches?
 - New headache?
 - New loss of smell or taste?
- Clean in/Clean out (i.e. clean every surface you are going to use when you arrive AND when you leave)
- Bathroom guidelines: wash hands thoroughly, Clean-In/Clean-Out bathrooms
- No shared food or beverages

Home Groups: Best Practices

If people wish to meet together in homes for life group or to watch the online services together, we recommend the above guidelines as well as considering these additional recommendations:

- Practice “Cohorting” (i.e. the same group each week without mixing with other groups)
- Meeting outside is better/safer and allows for better social distancing 6 feet apart
